NOTE:

- *No demolition material or industrial waste, chemicals or substances of dangerous or flammable nature will be collected
- *Do not pack bins too tightly as garbage may get stuck and not empty out
- *Bins will not be collected if a) Overfull b) Overweight or c) Incorrect Waste in Bin
- *Only 140L (red lid waste bin) and 240L (green lid recycle bin) will be collected

RED LID WASTE BIN:

- General Household Waste (Food scraps, Nappies)
- Batteries (Household)
- Clothing/ Textiles (or to Charity shops)
- Plastics (non recyclable), Glass, Crockery

GREEN LID RECYCLE BIN:

- Aerosol cans (empty)
- Glass jars & bottles (top off), Millk/Juice cartons
- Cans (steel & aluminium)
- Paper, Cardboard
- Plastics (Recyclable only)

TRANSFER STATION:

- Batteries (Car/ Commercial)
- Cars
- Chemical Drums (DrumMuster logo on drum) Free delivery for DrumMuster eligible drums
- Concrete/ Bricks (small quantities) contact CVW directly to discuss larger quantities
- E-waste (free drop off) Tvs, computers, electronics, white goods, appliances, electronic toys etc
- **■** Furniture
- Green Waste, Timber
- Paint Cans Remove lid, dry out paint
- Scrap Metal
- Waste Oil 20c per litre drop off at waste stations

OTHER:

- Asbestos Contact Environmental Protection Agency for advice on nearest disposal point
- Chemical Drums (Non DrumMuster) Contact manufacturer for nearest disposal point
- Gas bottles Contact manufacturer to arrange collection
- **Light globes** Accepted for free recycling at Mitre 10 stores
- Medicine Return to local pharmacy
- Mobile phones Mobile muster Council Offices and Post Offices
- Tyres Return to tyre retailers

Your Kerbside Waste Service

Councils kerbside waste collection includes a red lid bin for rubbish which is collected weekly and a green recycling bin which is collected fortnightly.

Bins placed kerbside on the incorrect collection day will not be collected.

Placing your bins kerbside

Bins should be placed kerbside the night prior to collection. Bins should be placed out front your property unless an alternative location has been provided to you by Council

My bin has been stolen

Stolen bins should be reported to the Police. Replacement bins can be purchased at the Burra and Eudunda Council office
