- 2. On the grounds that the information relates to information the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to prejudice the maintenance of law, including by affecting (or potentially affecting) the prevention, detection or investigation of a criminal offence, or the right to a fair trial. This order shall operate until 26th June 2018 and will be reviewed in 3 months.
- That Council authorise the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate with and appoint on the terms acceptable to the Chief Executive Officer – Minter Ellison to prepare the required documentation. CARRIED
