SAFETY TO BE IMPROVED AT THE BARRIER HIGHWAY INTERSECTION AT COPPERHOUSE ROAD AND SPRINGBANK ROAD, BURRA

Safety at the Barrier Highway intersection with Copperhouse Road and Springbank Road, Burra will soon be improved, through works to construct a staggered T-Junction.

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure, in collaboration with the Regional Council of Goyder, is delivering these important safety works to reduce the potential of right angle crashes, by offsetting the existing four-way intersection to form a staggered T- Junction, and installing a separated left turn lane on the Barrier Highway, for vehicles turning left onto Copperhouse Road.

Works have commenced Monday 7 January 2019, between the hours of 7.00am and 5.00pm, Monday to Saturday and are expected to be completed by April 2019, weather permitting.

The road will remain open, with traffic restrictions in place during construction. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact on road users.

This \$1.7 million safety initiative is funded by the State Government's Improved Rural Roads Program.

The Member for Stuart Dan van Holst Pellekaan stated that "Road safety will always be a top priority in our Electorate and I am very pleased the State Government and Regional Council of Goyder are working together to improve this important intersection."
