#### 1. ASSET MAINTENANCE

That Council adopt as Policy the allocation from general revenue and/or external funding sufficient funds to cover the expenditure requirements indicated by the Asset Management Plan (major maintenance schedule projected over the next 10 years) for buildings, CWMS, bridges, roads and transport infrastructure.

#### 2. ACCOUNTING - MATERIALITY

The assets purchased with a material value of less than \$2,000 that cannot be aggregated be treated as an operating expense. Computers purchased with a value of between \$1,000 - \$2,000 to be classed as fixed assets.

### 3. VALUATION OF COUNCIL LAND

3.1 Value of Land Under Roads

That Council elect not to recognise the value of land under roads in its valuation of Council assets, for roads acquired before 30/6/08, and that this policy be reported in the Notes accompanying the Financial Statements.

3.2 Value of CR (Crown Reserve) Land

That Council elects not to recognise the value of land in Councils Asset Register that is Crown Reserve (CR) that Council controls or is responsible for. This includes water, stone, road and recreation reserves.

#### 4. COMMUNITY FIXED ASSETS

Council resolves that there should be an agreement for the occupation of these properties based on a long term lease with maintenance and capital works being the responsibility of the leisure, sporting, recreational or similar body at their cost, with the onus being on that body to maintain those assets in a reasonable condition acceptable to Council.

Where a community group (referred to above) seeks to purchase the capital assets including the land or portion of the land of a Council non-commercial or tourism community fixed asset, Council will make every endeavour to achieve that objective, whilst ensuring that speculation based on future sale is not an underlying objective.

Where, after negotiation, the community group will not accept the conditions of occupation Council will by formal resolution:

- formally terminate the lease/agreement and approve the disposal of the asset in accordance with Council policy and statutory procedures, or
- take such other action as Council deems appropriate.

#### 5. DISPOSAL OF LAND

That a deposit of 10% be required at the signing of all contracts for the sale of land and that the balance of the sale price be paid in accordance with the sale contract.

### 6. RECOGNITION, REVALUATION AND DEPRECIATION

### 6.1 Capitalisation Principles

Definition of Capital Expenditure, the benefits of which will accrue to future years:

- Creates a new asset which will not be consumed by the Council within 12 months;
- Significantly lengthens the expected useful life of an existing asset and is not merely
  expenditure required to maintain the asset in normal efficient working order; and
- Significantly increases the earning capacity of an existing asset.

#### 7. VALUATION BASIS

The basis of valuation will be with regard to the following criteria:

- (a) If an existing asset would be replaced, valuation should be on the basis of written down replacement/current cost.
- (b) If an existing asset would not be replaced, the valuation should be on the basis of written down value.

#### 8. AGGREGATION

That like assets valued at less than \$2,000 be aggregated and capitalised if the total value of the items is greater than \$2,000.

### 9. DETERMINATION OF MATERIALITY OR RECORDING THRESHOLDS

That Council establish a monetary threshold for the recording of individual physical asset (including aggregation in item 3 and assets of a portable and desirable nature) of \$1,000 for computers and \$2,000 for all other assets.

#### 10. DEPRECIATION METHODS

That Council depreciates its infrastructure, plant, minor plant, office furniture and equipment by the straight line method taking into account estimated life of the asset and residual value.

#### 11. ESTIMATED USEFUL LIVES

Useful lives are estimated for each individual asset. In estimating useful lives, regard is had to technical and commercial obsolescence, as well as legal and other limitations on continued use. The range of useful lives for a representative range of assets is shown below, although individual assets may have an estimated total useful life of greater or lesser amount:

### 12. CWMS NETWORK, BRIDGES AND TRANSPORT ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE

The CWMS network, bridges and transports associated infrastructure are to be valued at depreciated current replacement cost and depreciated over the remaining useful life of the assets as determined at the most current date of valuation.

# 13. CLASSIFICATION, VALUATION AND DEPRECIATION BASIS FOR COUNCIL BUILDING AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE ASSETS

Council's Buildings and Associated Infrastructure are classified into the following 5 categories, being:

- 1. Core Council Activities
- 2. Council Core Community
- 3. Council Heritage & Self-Funding Buildings
- 4. Council Recreation
- External Council Core Activities

#### **Valuation and Depreciation**

Buildings and associated infrastructure in categories 1 to 3 are to be valued at depreciated replacement cost and depreciated over the remaining useful life of the assets as determined at the most current date of valuation.

Buildings and associated infrastructure in category 4 are to be valued at depreciated replacement cost and depreciated over the remaining useful life of the assets as determined at the most current date of valuation. In the event of a non-insurance loss situation it is recognised that Council would not replace the buildings and associated infrastructure.

Buildings and associated infrastructure in category5 are to be valued at depreciated replacement cost and depreciated over the remaining useful life of the assets as determined at the most current date of valuation. In the event of a non-insurance loss situation it is recognised that Council would not replace the buildings and associated infrastructure. These buildings are owned by a non-Council related entity.

#### 14. VALUATION OF ASSETS FOR INSURANCE PURPOSES

Council owned buildings and associated infrastructure are to be insured for full replacement value.
